2. Minimum cumulative G.P.A of 2.5.
3. Applicants must complete the application and be responsible for having a school official complete the relevant sections of the application.
4. Application must be returned by the specific date (April 3rd)
5. Applicant must include a college transcript (does not need to be an official copy).
6. Applicant must attach a letter of recommendation from a professor of one of your educational classes or an educator for whom you have worked with in a field experience confirming your commitment to the education field.
7. Must be a Park City Graduate.
